1 Welcome

Everyone introduced themselves to the meeting. Everyone welcomed our new member, TO to the group.

2 Covid Vaccination Update

ZW advised that vaccine uptake had been reasonable and the clinics were starting to fill up, however there is an element of vaccine fatigue. We would be focusing on a smaller cohort this time:

- Patients 75 and over
- Care Home Residents
- Patients who are immunosuppressed

ZW advised that the current vaccine being used is SpikeVax.

SB asked about shingles update. ZW advised that the guidance is as follows:

- The age range for those with very serious immunosuppression has dropped to age 50. The general population age range is being slowly dropped down to 60 but over a 10 year period so that vaccine stocks are not depleted too quickly. This year we are continuing to be able to vaccinate those turning 70 and up to age 80. We are also able to include those who will turn 65 01.09.2023 and 31.08.2024. So if your date of birth is between 01.09.1958 and 31.08.1959 we will text you after your birthday to invite you in.
